



CCS Summer Youth and Teen Programs Frequently Asked Questions

Do you have before and after care?

Yes, if a student is registered for Before and After Enrichment they can arrive as early as 8am and stay as late as 6pm. The cost per week is \$95. Parents and guardians who work in Detroit are eligible for free before and after enrichment.

How do I sign my child out early?

Call the office (313) 664-7456 and let them know when you will pick up your child. You will need to show a photo ID at the time of pick up.

What is your refund policy?

Students who do not wish to remain in a young artist camp for which they are registered for must call or email the Precollege and Continuing Studies office (313) 664-7456 or pcs@ccsdetroit.edu.

Students who withdraw at least 6 days prior to the first day of camp will receive a 100% refund. Students who withdraw 5 days or less before the first day of camp will receive a 100% refund minus a \$50 cancellation fee. No refunds are granted after the start of the second day camp session. Not attending a class does not constitute an official withdrawal from the camp.

My child missed some classes, may I get a refund or a credit?

No. Refunds will not be issued after the first day of class.

Is this a peanut free camp?

No.

Is there a Nurse on site?

No. First aid will be provided by the department of campus safety.

Can you accommodate my child?

CCS is an inclusive campus. All children are welcome. Our instructors and teaching assistants are not specifically trained to work with children with special needs. All children are expected to stay in the classroom, keep their hands to themselves, and be respectful of others. If your child is unable to meet these requirements or requires a one-on-one paraprofessional during the regular school year, this may not be the right fit for your child. Can students under the age 16 sign themselves in and out?

Students 15 years old and younger are required to be signed in and out by an authorized pick up with a photo ID. Parents/guardians may sign the "Public Transportation Release" waiver on CampDocs allowing any student who takes public transportation, rides their bike or walks to camp, or for extenuating circumstances in which the authorized pick up has mobility restrictions, to sign themselves in and out.

Can you assist my child in taking medications during the program?

No. CCS faculty and staff are restricted from administering medications.

Can a child under the age of 16 take Glassblowing or Welded Metal Sculpture?

No. OSHA restrictions do not permit students under the age of 16 to use the glass or metal shops at CCS.
