- **Watercolor Paint-** Winsor & Newton Artists Professional Watercolor or any high quality brand:
 - Cadmium Free Yellow
 - Cadmium Free Red
 - Sap Green
 - French Ultramarine Blue
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Perylene Maroon
 - Cerulean Blue
 - Burnt Umber
 - Titanium white
- **Watercolor Paper-**I use Fabriano Artístico 300lb. hot press watercolor paper cut to 8” x 10”. Please use your preferred brand of watercolor paper.
- **Watercolor Brushes-** you can use brushes that you already have or here are some options:
 - Winsor & Newton Series 7 Watercolor Brushes Size #3/0-#4
 - Raphael Kolinsky Brushes #8408: Ranging in size from #3/0 - #4
 - Synthetic Brushes with a fine, sharp point are good, such as Interlon #1026 ranging in size from #3/0-#2 and Interlon #417 at #3/0. Can be purchased at <https://drawbotanical.com/product/interlon-watercolor-brushes/>
- Porcelain Palette
- Container for water
- Pencils (2B, 2H), kneaded eraser
- Transfer Paper(optional)-I recommend MYARTSCAPE Graphite Transfer Paper A4 (8” x 11”), available at Amazon.
- Cotton rag to wipe brushes
