

Materials List for Essential Oils Perfume Workshop

In this class you'll be formulating two unique signature scents using beeswax, carrier oils, and essential oils. You'll create one solid perfume and a roll-on perfume. Good sources for essential oils are **Piping Rock** and **Plant Therapy**.

Perfume blends have a top note, middle note, and a bottom note so please choose 2-3 essential oils from each column:

Base Notes	Middle Notes	Top Notes
Amber	Black Pepper (to top)	Anise
Cedarwood	Chamomile	Basil
Cinnamon (to middle)	Geranium	Clary Sage (to middle)
Clove	Jasmine	Eucalyptus
Frankincense	Lavender	Grapefruit
Gardenia (can be base, middle, top)	Pine	Lemon
Myrrh	Rose (to base note)	Lime
Oakmoss	Rosemary	Orange
Patchouli	Violet	Peppermint
Sandalwood	Ylang Ylang	Sage
Vetiver		Spearmint
		Tea Tree (to middle)
		Thyme (to middle)

Other Supplies:

- Jojoba Oil – 1 small bottle (need about 1 ounce for each perfume and 4 ml for the roll on)
- Fractionated Coconut Oil – a small bottle (need 4 ml for the roll-on)
- Beeswax – a few ounces (will need 1 tablespoon of grated beeswax per solid perfume)

- Double boiler or 2 small saucepans
- Small glass to mix oils
