Materials list for THR301-Introduction to Horticultural Therapy-ONLINE

Session 1:

- (1) 4" x 6" piece of light color cardstock (re-purpose in Session 5)
- Assorted colored pencils, crayons or markers
- (1) black sharpie marker
- 1 qt. potting soil in a ½ size steam table, aluminum pan https://drive.google.com/file/d/1v9lrcvjv5rHQlwpakEeUOdIoGOW1_irl/view?usp=sharing
- Lavender buds (re-purpose in Session 5), mint sprigs (re-purpose in Session 5), uncooked rice & straw/hay-each in a separate brown paper bag

Important to Note

Leaf sections of the Sansevieria will be needed for Session 2.

Please make the cuttings 2-5 days prior to Session 2.

Session 2:

- (1) black sharpie marker
- 1 bag of dry potting soil, enough to fill (4) 4.5" pots; not garden soil.
- ½ size steam table, aluminum pan https://drive.google.com/file/d/1v9lrcvjv5rHQlwpakEeUOdIoGOW1_irl/view?usp=sharing
- 1 small trowel
- (2) 4-4.5" plastic pots (round)
- (2) 4.5" plastic saucers (to fit pots)
- (1) 3" coir or peat pots (round or square)
- (1) quart-size Ziploc bag
- (1) pair of gloves (plastic or old stretchy, knit gloves-not rubber gloves)
- Bandana or eye mask
- Plastic water bottle (18 or 20 oz.) filled with water nozzle top
- (3) 4-6" wooden plant/pot labels (or similar, like tongue depressors)

- (3) 3" leaf sections of a Sansevieria (snake plant)

- (1) 6" round of tulle or other porous, transparent fabric
- Assorted dried, colorful botanicals, enough to fill 8 oz. jar (i.e. rose, statice or sunflower petals)
- ½ c dry lavender buds (re-use from Session 1)

Session 6:

- (1) black sharpie marker
- potting soil, enough to fill (1) 4.5" pot; not garden soil.
