CRF222 - KUSUDAMA ORIGAMI – ONLINE

Below are the items you'll need to participate in our CRF222 class.

- Students will need square paper; preferably 6" x 6" (15cm x 15cm) or slightly smaller, and at least 30 sheets.
 - The instructor prefers if students can acquire origami paper as it is commonly found in the size listed above. Origami paper can be purchased from <u>Taro's Origami Studio</u>, your favorite online reatailer, and at most art supply/craft stores.
 - If other paper is used, it should be no thicker than regular copy/printer paper, and **newspaper/loose leaf/tissue paper is not recommended** as it is too weak/thin.
 - Scissors/a paper cutter might be required to cut the paper to the recommended size.
- Other **optional materials** would be double sided tape and paper clips. These tools are usually not required for folding or in the completed origami, but sometimes they can aid in assembling a kusudama.
