

Materials List For Painting 60s Bouquets in Psychedelic Colors

Drawing Supplies:

Artist quality 2H graphite pencils (recommended brands include Derwent, Tombow, and Staedtler Mars Lumograph)

Pencil Sharpener:

Battery operated: Look for a sharpener that has the spiral cutter not the blade cutter. (such as Omnitech) OR hand-held pencil sharpener: Kum Long Point Pencil Sharpener (Blick #21421-2980)

Erasers:

Kneadable rubber eraser recommended brands are Prismacolor or General or Design, White plastic eraser (Staedtler Mars) and Tombo Mono Zero Elastomer Eraser ultra Fine 2.3mm

Watercolor Paint (small tubes, 5ml)

Winsor & Newton professional grade watercolor tubes. Avoid student grade paints as they are difficult to work with and are not permanent.

Paper:

9X12 Arches 140lb. Hot Press watercolor pad or block.

Watercolor Brushes:

Rounds only (total: 3)

For painting - Kolinsky sable brushes (not long handle):

1 each: Raphael 8404 - #4

Or

1 each: Winsor & Newton Series 7 #4

And

Winsor & Newton Series 7 #2 miniature

For mixing paint 1 inexpensive synthetic brush #3 or #5:

Simply Simmons (white handle) or similar

Palettes:

2 White Ceramic 3" - 4" Round, 7-well ("flower")

And

White porcelain plate – inexpensive available at Marshalls, Home Goods

plastic deli containers for water (1/2 pint size)

Paper Towels: (a brand without texture such as Viva towels) and/or soft white cotton cloth

Eye Dropper or ear syringe (preferred)
