Face Masks

As state and federal protocols have been relaxed, and with more and more people being vaccinated, the university has revisited its face mask protocols. From this point and moving forward, face masks will no longer be required inside campus buildings for anyone who is fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Consistent with CDC guidelines, individuals who are not fully vaccinated should continue to wear face masks indoors. Additionally, face masks will no longer be required for anyone in outdoor settings.

Hand Sanitizer

Hand sanitizer stations, sanitizing wipes, and other disinfecting supplies will be located in all classrooms and throughout campus buildings.

Hand washing

The university strongly encourages frequent hand washing by all members of the campus community. While the CDC notes that touching a surface or object that has the virus on it is not the main way the virus spreads, good hand hygiene, including not touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands, is an essential protective measure that each person should follow.
