

### **Phiebotomy** COCC Professional Development: Non-credit Course



### WHAT PHLEBOTOMISTS DO

Phlebotomists work in hospitals, clinics, medical laboratories, and blood donor centers. Students will be trained to:

- Perform blood collection to obtain high quality specimens for clinical laboratory analysis:
  - Venipuncture
  - Skin puncture (capillary specimen)
  - Arterial puncture
- Process blood specimens to ensure appropriate tests are completed
- Ensure infection control and safety
- Perform blood draw on patients across the lifespan (infant, children, adult, and geriatric patients)
- Provide effective and responsive patient care

Upon completion of this class, graduates receive a certification of completion and are eligible to take the **National Healthcare Association or National Certified Phlebotomy Technician Certification exam.**
