What is the Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL)?

The ETPL in Oregon is a resource listing approved training providers and programs eligible for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funding [\[1\]](#).

What does the ETPL offer for individuals seeking training?

- Identifies suitable training providers and programs.
- Access to noncredit training certificates.
- Opportunity to gain skills without upfront costs.

Can individuals access WIOA funds through the ETPL?

Yes, ETPL aids in accessing WIOA funds for approved training programs.

What are the limitations of the ETPL in funding training?

- Availability of WIOA funds is subject to eligibility criteria and funding availability [\[1\]](#).

How might individuals benefit from the ETPL for noncredit training certificates?

- Explore the list of approved providers and programs.
- Learn more about potential training and education resources through Worksource Oregon.
- Contact local WorkSource offices for guidance on accessing WIOA funds.

Does the ETPL guarantee funding for training?

No, approval on the ETPL doesn't guarantee immediate funding. Individuals must meet specific eligibility criteria and fund availability [\[1\]](#).
