KTC STUDENT AGREEMENT

Manual Lymph Drainage (MLD) Certification Course

The following agreement is made between the participant registering for the Manual Lymph Drainage (MLD) Certification course and Klose Training & Consulting, LLC (hereafter KTC). Upon registering for this course, you will be asked to agree to the terms of this agreement. A copy of this agreement will be sent to you via email after you register.

Prerequisites

This course is designed for Licensed/Registered Massage Therapists who have a minimum of 500 hours of massage education or are certified through the NCBTMB. A copy of your school transcript or diploma showing 500 hours of training was completed, must be emailed to us at <u>continuinged@nwhealth.edu</u> within 10 days of registration. Please include in the subject line of your email "MLD prerequisite".

Registration

After registering for the course, you will receive a confirmation email with information relevant to preparing for the class.

Class Times

A total of 45 hours of classroom instruction is provided in the KTC MLD Certification Course over a 5 ½ day period. Class hours Tues – Sat from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Sun, 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Tuition & Refund Policy

Payment of \$1300 is due in full at the time of registration. If a student withdraws more than three (3) weeks before the start of the class, the student will be refunded their tuition within 10 business days, provided they have not been sent the precourse materials (including access to online learning modules), minus a nonrefundable administrative charge of \$100. No refunds will be given in the case of student cancellation less than three (3) weeks prior to the first day of class, or if the student has received the pre-course materials (including access to online learning modules), or at any time after the class has started, regardless of the reason for withdrawal or dismissal. The student has the option to decline the pre-course materials, including access to online learning modules, in which case the above stated terms for of the Tuition and Refund policy apply.

Attendance

100% attendance by each participant is expected. Additional hours for homework are typical. All students must be in class on time. Students who miss more than five (5) hours of the MLD Certification Course may not be permitted to take the final exam and subsequently will not receive a Certificate of Completion.

Certificate of Completion

In order to receive a Certificate of Completion at the end of the MLD Certification Course, tuition must be paid in full, all required documentation must be submitted, and a multiple-choice exam must be passed with a score of 80% or better. In addition, the instructor will visually evaluate and verbally test the student as needed to ensure competency.

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If the student loses or damages her/his Certificate of Completion, KTC will gladly replace it, upon request. The first replacement certificate is complimentary; additional replacement certificates will be subject to a \$15.00 fee plus the cost for postage.

Scope of Certificate/Certification

This MLD certification is not a "stand-alone" certification. Therapists treating clients with MLD must be in possession of an active license/diploma and work in compliance with the scope/guide of practice set forth for their profession by the state, county, and/or municipality in which they work. While the purpose of this course is to prepare the participant to safely and effectively work with and/or on patients using MLD, MLD certification must be regarded as adjunct to your existing professional license/diploma, e.g. your massage therapy license.

Cancellation of Classes

If a course is canceled due to an insufficient number of registrations, all moneys received will be refunded. In case of cancellation of the class for any other reason, such as the instructor falling ill, a new course will be scheduled, and all payments will be transferred.

Dismissal

Any participant may be dismissed from the program for insufficient progress, non-payment of tuition, or nonattendance. No tuition will be refunded. Reinstatement following dismissal is up to the discretion of the instructor.

Failing the Course

While KTC has a very high success rate in our MLD Certification Courses, occasionally, a student is unable to satisfactorily pass the written and/or practical exams. Failing students will not receive a Certificate of Completion. (Upon request, the student may receive a Certificate of Attendance or a letter verifying attendance.) Any student who does not pass the course will be allowed to repeat the course one additional time within one year at no tuition expense to re-learn the concepts of MLD and attempt to satisfactorily complete the exams. Should the participant fail to retake the course within one (1) year from the time of the original course or fail to complete the course successfully a second time, the student will be required to pay full course tuition again if they choose to retake the course later. Any tuition discount for a student repeating the course a third time is at the sole discretion of KTC.
