## **Underwater Design**

Flowers: The list below is offered as a general guideline. You are the designer... add or substitute as you wish. For Underwater you need a soft, flexible long stem flower.

Container: All Clear Glass containers. I will be using a bubble bowl and 2.5" x 5" rectangle

## **Underwater list of materials**

Flower & Materials sources: Trader Joes, Whole Foods, Michaels, Home Depot Alternative sources: Costco, supermarkets, farmers markets, gardens

**Floral Materials:** Your choice of complementary colors 10 stems Tulips: long stemmed 10 stems Mini Calla Lily

## **Design tools:**

Clean glass containers: 6" to 8" bubble bowl or deep round bowl and rectangle with 2.5" to 3" opening, height optional

Thin wire: your choice of color, Home Depot picture frame wire aisle or Michaels

Small Rocks or marbles: washed clean otherwise they cloud the water

Long wooden skewer sticks

Watering can with room temperature water

Cotton rag or paper towel

Container of water to wash tulip stems

Floral clippers, knife, wire cutters and scissor
