Watercolor Paper: 9x12" block of Arches 140lb Hot Press Watercolor Paper. (Do not

remove sheet of paper from block. Paper on a block is stretched for painting.)

Transfer or Carbon paper is optional. You will receive instructions for transferring your drawing using tracing paper.
