## Materials list for Botanical Drawing for Beginners (BIL145O)

#### **Instructor- Scott Rawlins**

**Drawing paper:** 9"x12" pad – medium vellum finish (not sketch or smooth finish) Recommended brands: Strathmore 400 medium surface or 500 vellum surface

Tracing paper: Canson Foundation Calque (as an example)

Artist quality graphite pencils: 2H, HB, 2B (1 each); recommended brands – Faber Castell, Derwent, Staedler Mars Lumograph, Prismacolor Turquoise

Pencil sharpener: electric (X-Acto) or hand held (Kum Automatic Long Point)

### Small Chamois Cloth or other lint free cloth

Erasers: Kneaded eraser (e.g. Design) and white plastic eraser (e.g., Staedtler Mars)

**Mini Dusting Brush:** Other good options – a large soft makeup brush, a large feather or Hake WC brush

#### 6" or 12" Ruler &/or Divider

Hand Lens: (10x) – or small magnifying glass

Micron Pen: 01

White Gouache: 1 tube -- zinc, titanium or permanent white

Colored pencils - waxy, artist quality: Prismacolor set of 24 (minimum) plus cream (PC914)

Prismacolor Verithin Colored Pencils - set of 12 (optional)

White Artists' Tape – approximately <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" to <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" in width

Small X-Acto Knife

Workable Fixative: Krylon (optional)

Bud vase (or something similar such as a floral water tube to hold flower while drawing)

Floral frog (to hold specimen) - at Michaels, A.C. Moore or Amazon
