- Glass bottle with tight-fitting lid
- Watercolor paper cut into small pieces for testing

- A brush, dip pen or other marking implements (a stick or feather would do)
- Access to a stove or heat source
- Old pot that you don't mind getting stained.
- Old spoon or stir stick that you don't mind getting stained.
- A bit of counter space to work on that is protected from spills
- Rag, paper towels, water soap for cleanup.
- Coffee filters, sieve or other method of straining
- Funnel
