Will consist of one drawing completed in either graphite, pen and ink or color,

Materials: There will be a number of handouts.

A laboratory notebook (if you have taken the Morphology course plan to continue in your existing workbook). Perhaps it would be a good idea to invest in fairly decent paper, if what you have been using is poor quality.

Art materials, pencils, erasers, Pens - Micron Technical Pens in .005, .01, and .02.

Course Structure: The session will be divided into two parts. First a talk and then drawing

The grading will be based solely on the final rendering in graphite, pen and ink or color
