- White kitchen towel
- An old brush for mixing paint or the 'Billy mixer' https://www.billyshowell.com/all-collection
- HB/F/H pencils, a set is useful
- Mars plastic eraser, and a putty rubber or blue/white tac, I prefer the latter.
- Polished stone for smoothing-optional (you can get polished stones from old costume jewellery)

These are the up to date materials that I use with links to best suppliers

- A large water pot and a Dab pad (old flannel to dab the brush onto)
- Magic eraser foam, just in case! Supermarkets carry this
- Hot pressed paper, I40lb, 200lb or 300lb in white (I00% cotton is best as it has the most resilience)
 Currently I am using the 200lb (425gms) Saunders Waterford hot pressed, it's important you try a
 few papers to find the one that suits you best. I also sell and use A5 Bockingford hot pressed paper,
 its good every day paper. Use scraps to test your colours. Here is a link for the Saunders paper
