- Basic drawing supplies from Drawing I and Drawing II
- Cheap pre-cut mat - interior dimensions 8x10 or larger
- Pad of highly translucent tracing paper - 11x14 (I recommend Canson tracing) We'll be using a lot of this!
- Good quality 11x14 drawing paper
- Basic colored pencils - these will be used later on in the course
- 12" ruler
- Scissors
- A variety of simple, small botanical objects of different sizes, values and shapes, to make into compositions. For example: nuts and their shells, small rocks, twigs and branch parts, dried leaves, pods, bark, feathers, berries and grasses. Also very small fruits and vegetables work as well. For example: grapes, strawberries, cherry tomatoes, tomatillos, garlic bulb, etc.
