The purpose of this grant is to address the needs of:

- Children and adolescents who, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, have increased mental health needs related to the consequences of the pandemic
- Children and adolescents who have new mental health or social-emotional needs related to the Covid-19 pandemic
- Parents of children engaged in mental health services through Wellness Recovery Action services

The populations served by this grant will include children, adolescents, and their families in the Metro East and Southern Illinois areas who are uninsured or underinsured.
